Summary:

The Subcommittee has not heard from Enid yet regarding the health information pages, therefore, the Subcommittee has chosen to move forward.

The report graph needs to be reformatted so that the public understands it and compare hospitals. Jon does not think that can be done because of the nature of how the data was collected. The report will be alpha, based on type of hospital and rates of infection; not conducive to comparison. Data is collected differently based on the different hospitals. The report will include rate and denominator information, but no numerator. Breakdown by hospital: Peds, teaching, trauma, and non-teaching. Jon stated that eventually we will be looking at data by unit but not presently.
