

1 Amend 17 Cal. Code of Regs. section 100090 to read:

2 **§ 100090. Additional Requirements for CIRM-Funded Derivation.**

3 (a) Where CIRM funds are to be used for research intended to derive a covered stem cell
4 line from human gametes, embryos, somatic cells or tissue, the SCRO committee must determine
5 the requirements of Code of California Regulations, title 17, section 100080, subdivision (a)(2),
6 have been met. For CIRM-funded derivation occurring after November 22, 2006, the SCRO
7 committee must also confirm that donors provided voluntary and informed consent in accordance
8 with Code of California Regulations, title 17, section 100100, subdivision (b).

9 (b) California Code of Regulations title 17, section 100090(a), does not apply to CIRM-
10 funded research intended to derive a covered stem cell line from somatic cells when the SCRO
11 committee has determined the requirements of California Code of Regulations title 17, section
12 100080, subdivisions (a)(3)(A) and (a)(3)(B), have been met.

13 (c) The modification of an acceptably derived stem cell line shall not be considered a
14 CIRM-funded derivation.
