Subject: Agenda of the Ninth Meeting, May 28, 2009

Enclosed is the agenda for the ninth meeting of the Forensic Alcohol Review Committee scheduled for May 28, 2009. The meeting previously scheduled for April 10, 2009, was not called to order because of a lack of a quorum. The three members in attendance did discuss the draft regulatory work products prepared by the subcommittee. At the rescheduled ninth meeting, the full committee will review the previous discussion and continue its review of the draft regulatory work products in its ongoing effort to evaluate the current California Department of Public Health's regulations pertaining to forensic alcohol analysis (Title 17, California Code of Regulations, Sections 1215 - 1222.2). The committee will consider revisions that are reasonably necessary to ensure the competence of the laboratories and employees to prepare, analyze, and report the results of the tests and comply with applicable laws. The current regulations are available on line at www.calregs.com. The draft regulatory work product is available from the website described below.
