**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY FOR PUBLIC REVIEW AND COMMENT:**

**1. DRAFT INTENDED USE PLAN FOR DRINKING WATER STATE REVOLVING FUND**

The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) is preparing to apply to the US Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) for the annual Safe Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (SDWSRF) capitalization grant of \$127 million for the fiscal year 2010. CDPH is hereby announcing the availability of the draft 2010 Intended Use Plan (IUP), which describes the proposed uses of the federal funds. Once finalized, CDPH will submit the IUP and related documents with the grant application to the USEPA.

**2. DRAFT 2010 GREEN PROJECT RESERVE LIST**

The 2010 federal SDWSRF appropriation bill requires that not less than 20% of the federal funds must be used for water or energy efficiency, green infrastructure, or other environmentally innovative activities. ("Green Project Reserve" or GPR). To meet the requirement of the FFY2010 grant, CDPH must identify at least \$25,391,600 in projects that can qualify for the GPR. CDPH has developed a list of water meter projects (Appendix D) in the 2010 SDWSRF PPL that may be funded. These water meter projects are categorically eligible for GPR. CDPH intends to invite water meter projects in category H with at least 20 bonus points for funding in late Fall 2010; these projects have an approximate total cost of \$44 million.
