**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY FOR PUBLIC REVIEW AND COMMENT:**

**1. DRAFT 2013 INTENDED USE PLAN FOR DRINKING WATER STATE REVOLVING FUND**

The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) is preparing to apply to the US Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) for the annual Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) capitalization grant of \$78.7 million for the fiscal year 2013. CDPH is hereby announcing the availability of the Draft 2013 Intended Use Plan (IUP) which describes the proposed uses of the DWSRF funds. Once finalized, CDPH will submit the IUP and related documents with the grant application to the USEPA.

**2. DRAFT 2013-2014 DWSRF FUNDABLE LIST**

The Draft 2013-2014 Fundable List consists of projects that CDPH, as of June 30, 2013, is currently reviewing for DWSRF funding eligibility. Projects that are found to be eligible for DWSRF funding will be targeted for a funding agreement by June 30, 2014.
