NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY FOR PUBLIC REVIEW AND COMMENT:

1. DRAFT 2012 INTENDED USE PLAN FOR SAFE DRINKING WATER STATE REVOLVING FUND

The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) is preparing to apply to the US Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) for the annual Safe Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (SDWSRF) capitalization grant of \$83.9 million for the fiscal year 2012. CDPH is hereby announcing the availability of the Draft 2012 Intended Use Plan (IUP) which describes the proposed uses of the SDSRF funds. Once finalized, CDPH will submit the IUP and related documents with the grant application to the USEPA.

2. DRAFT 2012-2013 SDWSRF FUNDABLE LIST

The Draft 2012-2013 Fundable List consists of projects that CDPH, as of June 29, 2012, is currently reviewing for SDWSRF funding eligibility. Projects that are found to be eligible for SDWSRF funding will be targeted for a funding agreement by June 30, 2013.
