- California Reportable Disease Information Exchange (CalREDIE) is a secure system that the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) has implemented for electronic disease reporting and surveillance.
- It is used by state and local public health officials, healthcare providers, and laboratories for communicable disease reporting and surveillance.
