HEALTH SERVICES AGENCY STANISLAUS COUNTY

Division: Public Health Services

Policy: Delegation of Authority to Declare a Local Public Health Emergency

Purpose: 1) To determine who has the authority to declare a public health emergency in the absence of the Public Health Officer (PHO)

2) To define the alternate's scope of practice

Procedure:

1. The public health officer retains all designated authorities and responsibilities until such time as he/she delegates them or is relieved of such by the county Board of Supervisors.
2. All delegation of authority is subject to the approval of the Managing Director of the Health Services Agency.
3. The H.S.A. Senior Management Team and the county Assistant Director of Emergency Services will be informed of the delegated designee.
4. In the absence of the PHO, the Assistant PHO will make the declaration. Delegation of Authority is not needed. In the absence of an Assistant Public Health Officer, the PHO will specifically delegate, in writing, his/her alternate, specifying the time period of delegation. **Exhibit A** specifies the preferred order of designated alternates.
5. **Exhibit B** is the algorithm for declaration of a public health emergency. The declaration must be in accordance with California Health and Safety Code # 101080.
6. **Exhibit C** is a sample Declaration of Public Health Emergency for Stanislaus County

Scope of Practice of Alternate Public Health Officer:

1. The Assistant PHO has all the full scope of practice of the Public Health Officer during his/her absence.

2. If there is no Assistant PHO, the scope of practice of the delegated alternate is limited to the declaration of public health emergency.
3. In the absence of the PHO and Asst PHO, the Associate Agency Director/PHS will coordinate the emergency response. She/he, will consult PHS staff, as needed, as well as the Agency's Communicable Disease Physician Consultant and/or Emergency Preparedness Physician Consultant.
4. If the PHO is unavailable to delegate authority, the Managing Director of the Health Services Agency will do so in accordance with this Policy and Procedure.

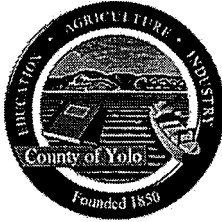
