PPSA 09-02-AB 1020, ANNUAL SURCHARGE FOR AB 1020

Recently, in policy letter PPSA 09-01-AB 1020, local public health and environmental health jurisdictions were informed of the passage of AB 1020. PPSA 09-01-AB 1020 also informed local jurisdictions of the annual surcharge that is to be collected by the applicable local jurisdiction, and transmitted to the Controller for deposit into the Recreational Health Fund.

This policy letter clarifies the amount of the surcharge to be collected by the applicable local jurisdiction. The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) has determined that the amount of the annual surcharge to be collected by the applicable local jurisdiction is \$6 (six dollars). Local jurisdictions must add the \$6 surcharge to their normal permit fees for public swimming pools that are due on and after January 1, 2010.

CDPH understands that this new law requires you to act quickly to include the surcharge in your billing schedule and encourages you to take the appropriate measures to comply. A copy of the surcharge remittance should also be sent to CDPH.
