- Develop policies for cohesive and coordinated efforts to improve health equity

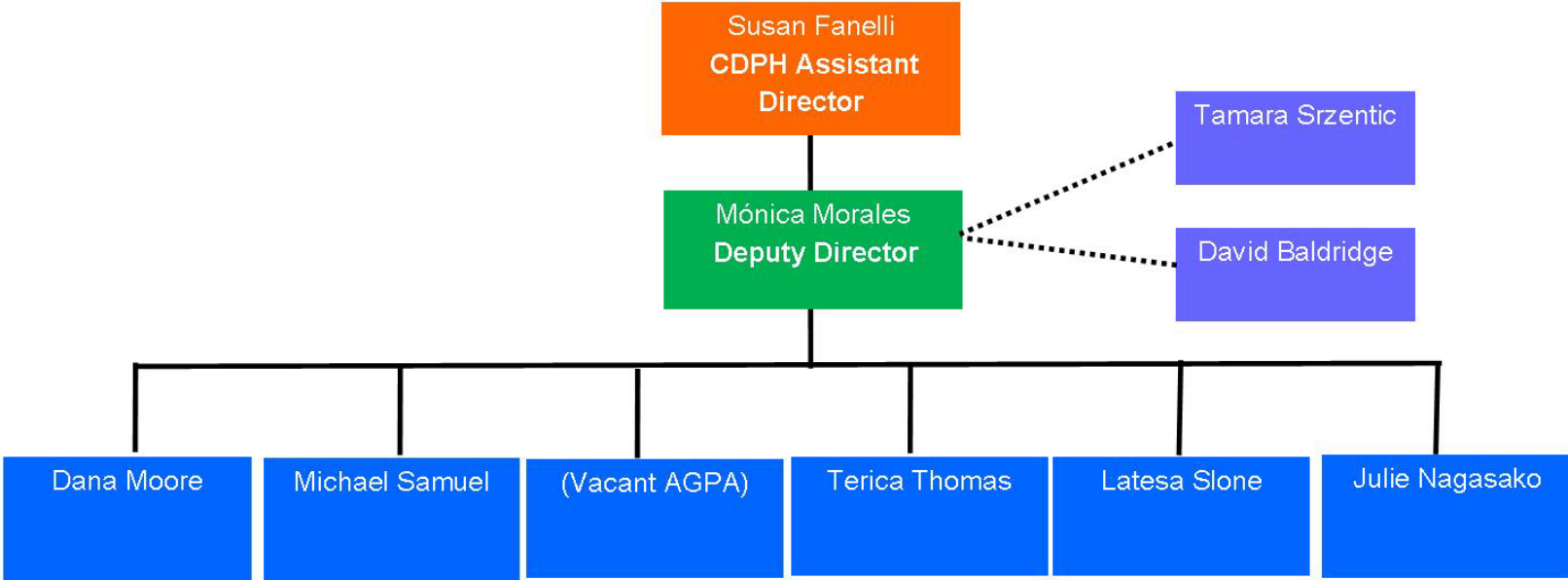
Key Functions of the Fusion Center

- Explore and pilot new funding models
