This Addendum 1 was issued to revise the Eligibility Criteria Qualification Requirements for RFA 25-10360, Native Youth Suicide Prevention. Changes made to the RFA are shown as:

Section C - Eligibility Criteria (Page 8)

1. Eligible Organizations

 California public or private non-profit organizations serving and led by American Indian/Alaska Native communities (i.e. a majority of the service population <u>for this program</u> and Board of Directors or staff leadership are American Indian/Alaskan Native), with a permanent business in California or are qualified through the Secretary of State to do business in California, are eligible to apply for these funds. This includes but is not limited to Tribal Health Programs and Urban Indian Organizations.
