Subject: Addendum 2 - Changes to Maximum Indirect Cost Rate

This Addendum 2 was issued to revise the maximum Indirect Cost Rate requirement for RFA 25-10360, Native Youth Suicide Prevention. Changes made to the RFA are shown as:

- Text that is added is displayed in bold underline.
- Text that is deleted is displayed in Strikethrough.

Section G - Budget Detail (Page 41)

• Indirect Costs –The reimbursable rate for Indirect Costs must not exceed a maximum of 20% 30.5% of the total budget. The reimbursable rate for Indirect Costs isn't a single universal number; it varies by entity and the specific funding source. If an organization has a pre-approved negotiated rate, that rate will be honored. If the organization does not have a negotiated rate with CDPH, in the budget justification, please provide a description of how the indirect cost rate is calculated (i.e. costs are based on personal and fringe or total cost Modified Total Direct Cost (MTDC)). If using MTDC provide list of line items included in the calculation. Indirect costs are expenses that are necessary for the general operation of an organization and are not specifically identified with a particular grant, project or activity (e.g., janitorial services, overhead costs, legal services), and are generally expressed as a percentage of total personnel costs plus fringe benefits.
