The Health Risk of These Products

- Mercury is a dangerous chemical that can seriously harm your health.
- CDPH testing found very high levels of mercury in these products.
- Any creams with a mercury concentration over 1 part per million (ppm) are illegal.
- These creams are often sold as products to clear blemishes, smooth wrinkles, or lighten skin.

If You or Someone You Know Uses Any of These Creams, Please

- See a doctor and get a urine test for mercury.
- Seal the product in a plastic bag and take it to your local hazardous waste facility.
