## **CDPH Launches Cosmetic Product Database**

A groundbreaking new California Safe Cosmetics Program (CSCP) online database allows nail

and hair salon workers and others to learn whether cosmetic products contain toxic chemicals.

California's first-of-its-kind <u>cosmetics law</u> requires cosmetic companies to report products containing ingredients known or suspected to cause cancer or reproductive harm.

This information is now easily accessible through a new, searchable database. Professionals who work with cosmetics and consumers can search for specific



products, companies, or chemical ingredients, and learn about how chemical exposure can affect health.

The <u>California Safe Cosmetics Program</u> is part of the <u>California Department of Public Health</u> (<u>CDPH</u>).
