

USING MICROFIBER CLOTHS FOR A HEALTHY CLASSROOM



Clean desks or tables with microfiber to remove dirt, grime, and germs, including during snack time and for art projects.



Keep classrooms healthy by cleaning with products that are also safer for asthma

REMEMBER:

1. Children are not allowed to use sanitizers or disinfectants, including disinfectant wipes.
2. Ideally, only trained custodians sanitize and disinfect when necessary. Examples include:
 - After removal of body fluids like vomit or blood
 - When recommended by the local health department, such as during an illness outbreak
 - When required by law, including food preparation surfaces in the kitchen
3. Staff and volunteers are required to take a Healthy Schools Act training in order to disinfect and sanitize in school, including using disinfectant wipes.
