
CALIFORNIA CHRONIC DISEASE PREVENTION LEADERSHIP PROJECT

IMPROVING POPULATION HEALTH AND EQUITY REQUIRES ADDRESSING THE DETERMINANTS OF HEALTH THROUGH POLICY, SYSTEMS AND ENVIRONMENTAL APPROACHES

- Healthcare costs high, outcomes poor by comparison.
- Rural healthcare crisis.
- Burden of disease distributed unfairly.
- Individual approaches to address risk factors for preventable disease.

Clinical prevention, management, treatment services


Community-centered individual patient education and case management services
