




## ACE's Ever Experienced by Children Ages 12-17 California, 2020-2021

Support implementation of ACE screening and response for Medi-Cal providers




#### **Networks of Care**

Reduce ACEs and toxic stress by half in one generation



- >12,400 Medi-Cal clinicians ACEs Aware certified




## **ACES AWARE: DATA UPDATE**

Percentage of Patients Ages 0 to 20 with ACE Score of 4 or More\*




#### Percentage of Patients Ages 21 to 64 with ACE Score of 4 or More \*

## ACE Screenings by Provider Type


