SUBJECT: FEE INCREASE EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2024

Effective July 1, 2024, the Food and Drug Branch (FDB) will increase fees by 20.3 percent as authorized by the Budget Act of 2023, in accordance with California Health and Safety (H&S) Code Section 100425. This increase and publication of the fee list is not subject to the regulation adoption requirements specified in Chapter 3.5 (commencing with section 11340) of Part 1, Division 3, Title 2 of the Government Code.

The new fee schedule was determined in accordance with the aforementioned Budget Act criterion based on a review of current expenditures and the revenues needed to support program administration.

The table below shows the current fees and the fee increases taking effect on July 1, 2024. The new amounts will be included in all billing invoices for payments required on or after July 1, 2024.

Notary fees will <u>**not**</u> change, as the current fee is \$15, the maximum allowed by the California Secretary of State.
