Microenterprise Home Kitchen Operation Adjusted Gross Annual Sales Limit

Assembly Bill 626- The Microenterprise Home Kitchen Operation allows for an adjusted gross annual sales limit based on the California Consumer Price Index (CPI). The California Retail Food Code Section below is the reference. As the CPI percent changes annually this information will be updated.

<u>113825.</u> (a) "Microenterprise home kitchen operation" means a food facility that is operated by a resident in a private home where food is stored, handled, and prepared for, and may be served to, consumers, and that meets all of the following requirements: (8) The operation has no more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) in verifiable gross annual sales, as adjusted annually for inflation based on the <u>California Consumer Price Index</u>.

The annual average adjustment rate is based on previous years CPI as follows:
