The Food Safety Inspector may request the following items (if applicable to your operations) for review to aid in the licensing determination:

- Food Safety Plan/Process Flow Diagram
- Production Records/Logs
- Sanitation Plan (including but not limited to Pest Control measures)
- Allergen Control Plan
- Product Lists and associated ingredient Suppliers
- Product Labels and advertising
- Photos of facility production areas
- Additional documentation pertaining to your specific products or process

We appreciate your cooperation and patience with this process. It is our mission to protect and enhance the public health and well-being of all. We accomplish this for California through sound science and evidence-based enforcement of food laws and regulations.
