The funding for the grant is from the *California Healthcare, Research, and Prevention Tobacco Tax Act of 2016*, Proposition 56.

Proposition 56, which is an excise tax increase on tobacco products sold in the state of California was approved by state voters in November 2016. Funds from the projected tobacco sales revenue will be allocated for distribution to local law enforcement agencies via a grant program in conjunction with the California Department of Public Health, Food and Drug Branch, Tobacco Enforcement Section/Stop Tobacco Access to Kids Enforcement Program.
