

CALIFORNIA CANNABIS TRACK-AND-TRACE (CCTT-METRC) SYSTEM WORKSHOPS


EDUCATIONAL WORKSHOPS FOR CURRENT CCTT-METRC USERS



If you're a provisional or annual cannabis licensee, we invite you to join us at one of our free workshops for an overview of the California Cannabis Track-and-Trace (CCTT-Metrc) system. CCTT-Metrc is being used statewide to record the inventory and movement of cannabis and cannabis products through the commercial cannabis supply chain – from cultivation to sale. All commercial cannabis licensees operating under a state-issued provisional or annual license are required to use the CCTT-Metrc system.

The CCTT-Metrc system integrator, Metrc, LLC, will provide a system overview targeted to current CCTT-Metrc users. The presenters will review the questions most often asked about the system, and will provide demonstrations to help cannabis licensees avoid common mistakes. Representatives from the California Department of Food and Agriculture's CalCannabis Cultivation Licensing Division and the California Department of Public Health's Manufactured Cannabis Safety Branch will also provide brief presentations. A question-and-answer session will be held at the end of each workshop.
