**EXEMPTION TO CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS (CCR)
Extension of Time Period for Examination Passage**

Title 17, Section 30405(b)(2)

Pursuant to California Health and Safety Code (HSC) §115060 and Title 17, California Code of Regulations, §30104(a), the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) may grant exemptions from the requirements of applicable regulations, either upon request or on its own initiative. CDPH hereby grants an exemption from the requirements of 17 C.C.R. §30405(b)(2), which provision requires that applicants for certificates, permits, or other authorizations pass applicable required examinations within one year of notice from CDPH of receipt of an acceptable application. Pursuant to the granted exemption, the period allowed for passage of any applicable required examination is hereby extended from one year, to 18 months. All other requirements as set out in 17 C.C.R. § 30405 shall remain in effect.

This exemption is valid until rescinded.
