Hunters Point Naval Shipyard Parcel A-1, Radiation Health and Safety Scanning Survey: Progress Update #13

This Progress Update combines the scanning survey results for the weeks of October 15 and October 22. For both weeks, the CDPH Radiological Health Branch continued the walkover survey scanning of the remaining construction area and detected no anomaly. Other than a small area that has a temporary office and metal bulk containers that cannot be moved at this time, the walkover and towed array scanning of Parcel A-1 is complete. CDPH will now focus on completing the A-1 final survey report.

In addition, CDPH began the scanning for Parcel A-2 on October 22. CDPH will continue to update A-1 residents on the progress of the A-2 scanning with similar updates.

CDPH appreciates residents' assistance to facilitate this survey effort, ranging from moving parked cars to the various suggestions and inquiries that led to an improved work plan.
