- 1. Is my prescription painkiller an opioid?
- 2. Is there a safer medication to take? If yes, what is it?
- 3. What are the side effects?
- 4. What happens if I'm taking this medication and I'm pregnant or planning on becoming pregnant?
- 5. Is it safe to breastfeed while on this medication?
- 6. Can I get addicted to this medication? If so, how will I know?
- 7. What should I do with my leftover prescription drugs?

Have you been prescribed an opioid?

Certain types of prescription painkillers are opioids. Opioids can cause problems for a developing baby, even before you know you are pregnant. Here are some important questions to ask your doctor. Take a picture of them to help you remember what to ask.
