The population count of children (ages 0–9) is an annual estimate of California resident children (ages 0–9).

The population count of children (ages 0–9) shown in these dashboards is the estimated number of California resident children (ages 0–9), stratified by selected demographic characteristics. The 95% confidence interval presented in the tooltips indicates there is a 95% chance that the range contains the true prevalence or rate in the population. Rates or percentages with wide confidence intervals should be interpreted with caution. See Category and Subcategory Definitions below for additional inclusion/exclusion criteria.

## **Data Suppression**

The numerator, rate, and confidence interval are not shown when the numerator is less than 10.

## **Category and Subcategory Definitions**

**Age:** Age of child.

**Race/ethnicity:** Hispanic includes all persons of Hispanic origin of any race. Multi-Race includes those of non-Hispanic origin who reported more than one race. The remaining groups are of non-Hispanic origin who reported a single race: American Indian or Alaska Native (AIAN), Asian, Black, Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander (Pacific Islander), or White.

**Sex:** Sex of child.
