## VENDOR ALERT 2013 - 08

TO:	ALL WIC VENDORS
SUBJECT:	STOLEN FOOD INSTRUMENTS
Purpose	The California Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) Program has become aware that approximately 192 blank and voided food instruments (FI) have been stolen. Vendors should check the serial number of FIs presented at their store location to prevent a financial loss by accepting stolen FIs.
Vendor Responsibility	It is important that vendors verify the authenticity of the FI prior to accepting it as payment for WIC supplemental foods. The FIs with the serial numbers listed below were stolen and if presented have been altered; they should not be accepted.

Verify FI Submissions	Ensuring you follow the proper FI handling techniques helps protect you from financial loss by accepting a stolen FI. Vendors are encouraged to verify the acceptance of submitted FIs through Vendor WIC Information Exchange (VWIX) prior to depositing the FI into your bank. Counterfeit or altered FIs will not be reimbursed by the WIC Program through the normal submission process and returned checks may be subject to bank fees.
Possession of Stolen WIC FIs	If you come into possession of a suspected stolen FI, report it to the WIC Program immediately at WICABUSE@cdph.ca.gov.
