# 2018 Educational Road Show "Preventing HAI: Do you know if your hospital providers are doing the most important things consistently?"

# **Course Description:**

The HAI Program is pleased to present a 20-city educational roadshow to review evidence-based care practices known to prevent common hospital-onset healthcare-associated infections (HAI), share adherence observations from California hospitals, and discuss how hospitals can establish adherence monitoring programs. The three-hour course will be held 23 times (three in Los Angeles) during April-May 2018.

#### Intended Audience:

Hospital infection preventionists should attend with a hospital leader, nursing director, or quality improvement director who can provide authority or oversight for implementing a facility-wide infection prevention adherence monitoring plan

### **Objectives:**

- 1. Review evidence-based practices known to prevent HAI in the hospital setting
- 2. Describe results of HAI Program adherence observations in California hospitals
- 3. Discuss how to establish an adherence monitoring program
