“Basics of Infection Prevention in Outpatient Hemodialysis Centers”

The HAI Program is pleased to announce a 6-hour basic infection prevention educational workshop for outpatient dialysis facility administrators and staff for the fourth consecutive year. The course will be held in ten locations throughout California from March to June 2019. There is no cost to attend, however space will be limited. **Pre-registration is required.**

Course Description:

This course is intended to provide an overview of basic infection prevention principles in the outpatient dialysis setting, including the topics hand hygiene, standard precautions, personal protective equipment (PPE), environmental cleaning and disinfection, bloodstream infection (BSI) prevention, safe infection practices, and infection surveillance and reporting using the National Healthcare Safety Network (NHSN).

Suggested Audience:

- Dialysis facility administrators, quality improvement staff, and clinical managers interested in learning more about infection prevention strategies.
- Registered nurses, licensed vocational nurses, and dialysis technicians, with infection prevention responsibilities or interest in infection prevention.

Primary Objectives:

1. Identify evidence-based practices for BSI prevention
2. Discuss practices to reduce the risk of healthcare-associated infections that may be related to contaminated environmental surfaces and equipment
3. Review importance of proper hand hygiene practice
4. Review standard and transmission-based isolation precautions
5. Discuss the impact of unsafe injection practices on patient and health care worker safety
6. Discuss the importance of infection surveillance and use of NHSN
