

# If You Work or Volunteer in a Child Care Setting... **Protect Against Measles, Whooping Cough & Flu**



## **Child Care Staff and Volunteers Need Proof of:**

- **Flu vaccine – every year**
- **Pertussis** (whooping cough) **vaccine**
- **Measles vaccine**

## **Protect Yourself**

Child care staff and volunteers in California are required to show proof of vaccination against these dangerous diseases: measles, whooping cough, and flu.

## **Protect Our Children**

You can spread deadly diseases even before you feel sick. Getting vaccinated helps keep the children you care for safe.

## **Avoid Missing Work**

If you get sick, you can miss weeks of work. Vaccines are safe and help you stay healthy.

\*Day care center teachers (but not volunteers and other employees) may provide a certificate indicating they have been assessed for tuberculosis (TB) risks, and if risk factors were identified, they have been found to be free of infectious TB per Health and Safety Code section 121525.
