Compatibility

Make sure you are using a compatible web browser. **CalREDIE** is <u>NOT</u> compatible with Internet **Explorer.** Please make sure to use one of the newly supported browsers.

- For PC: Google Chrome, Microsoft Edge, or Firefox
- For Mac: Safari

Turn Off Pop-Up Blocker for CDPH Sites

Google Chrome Instructions

- 1. Click the three-dot icon in the top-right corner of the browser window, then click *Settings*.
- 2. Under Advanced, click Privacy and security.
- 3. Scroll through the menu options, then select **Site Settings**.
- 4. Scroll through the menu options, then select **Pop-ups and redirects**.
- 5. Nextto "Allow", click Add.
- 6. In the pop-up window, type [*.]cdph.ca.gov, then click Add.

Microsoft Edge Instructions

Microsoft Edge does not allow for users to modify a list of pop-up permissions. To allow popups in the Provider Portal, login and create a report. When a pop-up needs to open, you will see a prompt at the bottom of the browser stating, "Microsoft Edge blocked a pop-up from [site]". Click **Always allow**.

Apple Safari Instructions

- 1. In a new tab or window, navigate to CalREDIE.
- 2. From the menu bar at the top of the screen, select Preferences.
- 3. From the taskbar in the pop-up window, click **Websites**.
- 4. From the left-hand column, select **Pop-up Windows**.
- 5. Under **Currently Open Websites**, find "calredie.cdph.ca.gov" and select **Allow** from the menu.

Mozilla Firefox Instructions

- 1. Click the three-line icon in the top-right corner of the browser window, then click *Options*.
- 2. On the left-hand taskbar, click **Privacy & Security**.
- 3. Scroll down in the Privacy & Security menu until you reach the **Permissions** section.
- 4. Across from the **Block pop-up windows** checkbox, click on *Exceptions*.
- 5. Type https://calredie.ca.gov into the Address of website field, then click the *Allow* button, and then *Save Changes* at the bottom of the the window.
