## What is CalREDIE?



California Reportable Disease Information Exchange (CalREDIE)
is the California Department of Public Health's (CDPH)
communicable disease reporting and surveillance system of record.

• It is used by state and local public health officials and healthcare providers for communicable disease reporting and surveillance.

## What is the Provider Portal (PP)?

- Secure, web-based interface within CalREDIE
- Platform to electronically submit Confidential Morbidity Reports (CMRs)

Reporter submits incident via PP

Information automatically sent to CalREDIE
