SUBJECT: ADAP RECERTIFICATION PROCESS UPDATE

The purpose of this memo is to inform ADAP Enrollment Workers that the ADAP recertification process has changed to allow eligible clients to recertify over the phone. This option is available to ADAP clients who continue to meet ADAP eligibility requirements. If clients have not had any changes to residency and health insurance/other third-party payer coverage, and annual household income remains within program limits, they can now recertify over the phone by contacting the ADAP Call Center, their ADAP Advisor, or ADAP EnrollmentWorker.

ADAP Staff and ADAP Enrollment Workers will confirm with clients over the phone that residency and health insurance/other third-party payer coverage has not changed, and annual household income remains within program limits. If the client attests over the phone that they still meet the ADAP eligibility requirements outlined above, the ADAP Staff or ADAP Enrollment Worker will update the ADAP Enrollment System (AES) by completing the following actions:

- Select "SVF" from the Client Profile
 - Answer "Yes, the information is current and accurate"
 - Select "Upload"
 - Select Document Type "Supporting Documentation"
 - Upload Self-Verification Form (SVF) Blank Supporting Document (BSD)

 - Select "Submit SVF"
- Create the following Case Note on the Client Profile in the AES:
 - "Client attested via phone there are no changes to their residency and insurance coverage, and their annual household income is still within program limits. Processed SVF and uploaded SVF-BSD Document."
