ADAP's Mission

To provide eligible California residents living with HIV/AIDS access to life-saving medications, accomplished through:

- ADAP's medication assistance program: providing prescription coverage for HIV/AIDS and associated medications on the approved ADAP Formulary.
- ADAP's insurance assistance programs, including:
 - The Office of AIDS Health Insurance Premium Payment (OA-HIPP) Program.
 - The Employer Based Health Insurance Premium Payment (EB-HIPP) Program.
 - The Medicare Premium Payment Program (MPPP).





How do Clients Enroll into ADAP?

- Only certified enrollment workers can enroll clients into ADAP
 - Authorized enrollment sites can be located on the <u>ADAP Geomap</u>
 - The ADAP GeoMap also outlines which sites are open or closed.
- Enrollment may be done in person, via phone, or via fax/email
- A certified enrollment worker will screen the client to ensure they meet ADAP eligibility requirements





Overview of ADAP Eligibility Requirements

- 18 years of age or older
- Be a California resident
- Positive HIV or AIDS diagnosis
- Have a modified adjusted gross income (MAGI) that does not exceed 500% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL), based on household size and income
- Not be fully covered by Medi-Cal, or any other insurance







Due annually by the client's birthdate.



Can be done up to 45-days in advance.

Annual ADAP Re-Enrollment



Reminder is mailed to the client at least 45-days prior to their birthdate. Clients with access to the Client Portal will also receive an electronic notification.



Re-enrollment may be done in person, via phone, or via fax/email.



The Enrollment Worker submits a re-enrollment application through the AES and uploads a new <u>Client Attestation Form</u> and <u>Consent</u> <u>Form</u>, and updates other supporting documents per ADAP eligibility guidelines.



Coverage Group	The ADAP Pays For
ADAP Only clients (no other form of coverage)	ADAP covers 100% of prescription drug costs
Medi-Cal Share of Cost clients (with no Medicare Part D)	ADAP Covers 100% of prescription drug share of cost
Private Insurance clients (including clients with Covered California, off-exchange, employer based, and COBRA coverage)	ADAP covers prescription drug deductibles and copays
Medicare clients	ADAP covers the Medicare prescription drug deductibles and co-pays.

How Does ADAP Coordinate with Other Forms of Insurance?

The ADAP only covers prescriptions on the approved ADAP Formulary



Insurance Assistance Programs

OA-HIPP

The Office of AIDS Health Insurance Premium Payment Program assists clients with paying for their on-exchange and off-exchange private health insurance premiums and medical out-of-pocket (MOOP) expenses.

EB-HIPP

The Employer Based Health Insurance Premium Payment Program assists clients with paying for their portion of their employer sponsored health insurance premiums and MOOPs.

MPPP

The Medicare Premium Payment Program assists clients with paying for Part D and/or Part C, Medigap premiums, and MOOPs.
