SUBJECT: ADDITION OF INFLUENZA VACCINES TO THE PrEP-AP FORMULARY

Effective January 23, 2023, the following influenza vaccines have been added to the PrEP-AP formulary: Afluria[®], Fluad[®], Fluarix[®], Flublok[®], Flucelvax[®], Flulaval, Fluzone[®], Fluzone[®]-High Dose. The addition of these influenza vaccines will provide PrEP-AP clients with more treatment options to protect against the influenza virus.

In addition to being available in pharmacies, influenza vaccines will also be available to PrEP-AP clients for administration in a clinical setting. Uninsured, confidential, immediate access, and minor clients must receive physician-administered medications from our contracted clinical providers who may be located here: Prep-AP Clinical Providers and Enrollment Sites. Prep-AP requests that you share this information with your clinical leadership team and local prescribers. The Prep-AP formulary has been updated to reflect the addition of the influenza vaccines.
