

WHAT IS A HEALTHY COMMUNITY AND ITS' INDICATORS? (V2.9-19-14)

ASPIRATIONAL GOAL: Meets Basic Needs of All

- **Domain:** Safe, Sustainable, Accessible and Affordable Transportation Options. Indicators include:
 1. ([Available online](#)). Annual number of fatal and severe road traffic injuries per population and per miles traveled by transport mode.
 2. ([Available online](#)). Annual miles traveled by occurrence and by mode.
 3. ([Available online](#)). Percent of residents aged 16 years and older mode of transportation to work.
 4. ([Available online](#)). Percent of population residing within <½ a mile of a major transit stop.
 5. Percent of household income spent on transportation.
 6. ([Available online](#)). Percent of population aged 16 years or older whose commute to work is 10 minutes per day or more by walking or biking.

- **Domain:** Affordable, Accessible and Nutritious Foods. Indicators include:
 1. ([Available online](#)). Average cost of a market basket of nutritious food items relative to income.
 2. Percent of population within ½ mile of a full-service grocery store, fresh produce market, or store with fresh produce.
 3. Percent of adults who consume ≥5 servings of fruits & vegetables a day.
 4. ([Available online](#)). Modified retail food environment index (mRFEI).

- **Domain:** Affordable, High Quality, Socially Integrated and Location-Efficient Housing. Indicators include:
 1. ([Available online](#)). Percent of households paying more than 30% (or 50%) of monthly household income towards housing costs.
 2. ([Available online](#)). Percent of household overcrowding (> 1.0 persons per room) and severe overcrowding (> 1.5 persons per room).
 3. ([Available online](#)). Household by type of family and head of household.
 4. Neighborhood Completeness Index (<½ mile radius for 7 out of 9 common public services and 9 of 12 common retail services).
 5. ([Available online](#)). Housing to jobs ratio.
 6. ([Available online](#)). Jobs: housing match (example: Percent of adult working population who could find a job that matches their general occupational qualifications within a specified travel radius of their residence).
 7. ([Available online](#)). Neighborhood change: 5-year change in number of households by income and race/ethnicity.
 8. Residential racial segregation: isolation index.

ASPIRATIONAL GOAL: Meets Basic Needs of All (continued).

- **Domain:** Affordable, Accessible and High Quality Health Care. Indicators include:
 1. Percent of adults aged 18 to 64 years without health insurance.
 2. Patient satisfaction rating by medical group.
- **Domain:** Complete and Livable Communities. Indicators include:
 1. Neighborhood Completeness Index (<½ mile radius for 7 out of 9 common public services and 9 of 12 common retail services).
- **Domain:** Access to Affordable and Safe Opportunities For Physical Activity. Indicators include:
 1. Percent of adults getting moderate/vigorous daily exercise.
 2. ([Available online](#)). Percent of children scoring 6 of 6 on Fitnessgram.
- **Domain:** Able To Adapt To Changing Environments, Resilient, and Prepared for Emergencies. Indicators include:
 1. Cities and counties with adopted climate action plans and FEMA-approved local hazard mitigation plans.
 2. Environmental resilience index (index composed of places with climate action and hazard mitigation plans and other Healthy Community Indicators -unemployment, lacking health insurance, educational attainment, income inequality, and registered voters-).
- **Domain:** Opportunities for Engagement with Arts, Music and Culture. Indicators include:
 1. Per capita revenue in nonprofit arts organizations.
 2. Percent of workers employed in artistic occupations.

ASPIRATIONAL GOAL: Quality and Sustainability of Environment

- **Domain:** Clean Air, Soil and Water, and Environments Free of Excessive Noise. Indicators Include:
 1. ([Available online](#)). Annual average number of unhealthy days of ozone air pollution.
 2. ([Available online](#)). Annual mean ambient concentration of fine particulate matter (PM2.5).
 3. Percent of households/population near busy roadways.
 4. Average daily water use per capita.
 5. ([Available online](#)). Percent of the population served by community water systems not meeting regulations of the Safe Drinking Water Act.
 6. Average daytime and night time outdoor noise levels.
- **Domain:** Tobacco and Smoke Free. Indicators Include:
 1. ([Available online](#)). Prevalence of smoking in adults and youth.
- **Domain:** Green and Open Spaces, Including Agricultural Lands. Indicators include:
 1. ([Available online](#)). Percent of population within ½ mile of park, beach, open space, or coastline.
 2. Acres of parkland per 1,000 residents.
 3. Acres of cropland converted to developed land.
 4. Tree canopy coverage (urban areas).
- **Domain:** Minimized Toxics, GHG Emissions and Waste. Indicators include:
 1. Pounds of toxic chemicals released by reporting facility per capita/geographic area.
 2. Reported pesticide use.
 3. Annual per capita greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions.
 4. Total waste diversion (per capita disposal rate).
- **Domain:** Affordable and Sustainable Energy Use.
 1. Energy costs relative to household income.
 2. Percent of electricity from renewable sources.

ASPIRATION GOAL: Adequate Levels of Economic, Social Development

- **Domain:** Living wage, safe and healthy job opportunities for all. Indicators Include:
 1. ([Available online](#)). Unemployment rate: percent of the population in the labor force who are unemployed.
 2. ([Available online](#)). Overall, concentrated, and child (0 to 18 years of age) poverty rate.
 3. Number and rate of fatal and nonfatal occupational injuries by industry.
 4. ([Available online](#)). Living wage and percent of families with incomes below the living wage.
- **Domain:** Support for Healthy Development of Children and Adolescents. Indicators include:
 1. Percent of children who are kindergarten ready.
 2. Percent of resilient high school students.
 3. ([Available online](#)). Number of licensed daycare center slots per 1,000 children aged 0 to 5 years.

ASPIRATION GOAL: Health and Social Equity. Indicators Include:

1. Race/ethnicity equity score as a composite of multiple core indicators, including median income.
2. ([Available online](#)). Distribution of household income relative to the number of households, expressed on a 0 to 1 scale (Gini Index).
3. Place-based equity score as a composite of multiple core indicators calculated for census tracts.

ASPIRATION GOAL: Social Relationships that are Supportive and Respectful

- **Domain:** Robust Social and Civic Engagement. Indicators include:
 1. ([Available online](#)). Percent of adults (18 years or older) who are registered voters; percent of adults who voted in general elections.
- **Domain:** Socially Cohesive and Supportive Relationships, Families, Homes and Neighborhoods. Indicators include:
 1. Number of Forcible Rapes per 100,000 population.
 2. ([Available online](#)). Percent of children (<18 years) reported with neglect or physical sexual abuse.
- **Domain:** Safe Communities, Free of Crime and violence. Indicators include:
 1. ([Available online](#)). Number of violent crimes per 1,000 population.
 2. ([Available online](#)). Percent of the population within ¼ mile of alcohol outlets by type of establishment sales.
