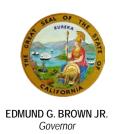

NOTICE OF PROPOSED EMERGENCY REGULATORY ACTION

CANNABIS REGULATIONS FOR CEQA COMPLIANCE AND SHARED-USE FACILITIES DPH-17-013E

Pursuant to Government Code section 11346.1(a)(2), and California Code of Regulations, Title 1, section 48, notice is hereby given that the California Department of Public Health (Department) proposes to adopt on an emergency basis Chapter 13 in Title 17, California Code of Regulations, Division 1.

This notice is being provided at least five working days prior to the filing of the proposed emergency regulatory action with the Office of Administrative Law.
