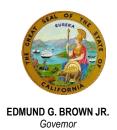

September 24, 2018 NOTICE OF PROPOSED READOPT OF EMERGENCY REGULATIONS Cannabis Regulations for CEQA Compliance and Shared-Use Facilities DPH-17-013E

Pursuant to Government Code section 11346.1(a)(2), and California Code of Regulations, Title 1, section 48, notice is hereby given that the California Department of Public Health (Department) proposes to readopt on an emergency basis Chapter 13 in Title 17, California Code of Regulations, Division 1.

This notice is being provided at least five (5) working days prior to the filing of the proposed readopt of the emergency regulatory action with OAL. If you would like to make comments on the Finding of Emergency, comments must be received by both the Department and OAL within five calendar days of the Department's filing with OAL. Responding to these comments is strictly at the Department's discretion.

A copy of the text of the proposed emergency regulations and a finding of the emergency are enclosed. You may also review the proposed regulatory language and Finding of Emergency, including the specific sections to be readopted on the Department's website at: https://www.cdph.ca.gov/Programs/OLS/Pages/Proposed-Regulations.aspx

Upon filing, OAL will have ten (10) calendar days within which to review and make a decision on the proposed readopt of the emergency rulemaking. If approved, OAL will file the regulations with the Secretary of State, and the emergency regulations will become effective on the day of filing. This notice is solely a notice of intent to readopt the emergency regulations and should not be confused with the notice specified in Government Code sections 11346.4 and 11346.5. The Department commenced a 45-day public comment period and published its notice to make these regulations permanent on July 13, 2018. Subsequently, the Department held three public hearings and the comment period closed on August 27, 2018.
