## NOTICE OF PROPOSED EMERGENCY REGULATORY ACTION Hospice Agencies DPH-18-002E December 1, 2025

Pursuant to Government Code SECTION 11346.1(a)(2), and California Code of Regulations, Title 1, section 48, notice is herby given that the California Department of Public Health (Department) proposes to adopt on an emergency basis Title 22, Division 5, Chapter 6.5. Article 1 of the California Code of Regulations, to be in effect January 1, 2026.

This notice is being provided at least 5 working days prior to the proposed emergency regulation action with the Office of Administrative Law (OAL). A copy of the text of the proposed emergency regulations and finding of emergency are enclosed and available for review on the Department's website at: <a href="CDPH Office of Regulations">CDPH Office of Regulations</a>.

After submission of the proposed emergency regulations to OAL, OAL shall allow interested persons five calendar days to submit comments on the proposed emergency regulations as set forth in Government Code section 11349.6 to the OAL reference attorney by mil to 300 Capitol Mall, Suite 1250, Sacramento, California 95814, by fax (916) 323-6826 or by email to staff@OAL.ca.gov.

This notice is solely a notice of intent to file the proposed emergency regulations and should in no way be confused with the notice specified in Government Code sections 11346.4 and 11346.5. The Department shall provide separate notice of the subsequent 45-Day Public Comment period, during which you may submit comments regarding the regulations.
