## For service of subpoenas read each option below carefully:

<u>For subpoenas requesting medical or investigation records</u>, you must serve the subpoena on the appropriate district office that licenses the health facility in question, either by personal service or via US mail. These subpoenas will not be accepted by mail at our legal office address.

A list of the district offices and the counties they cover is available at the <a href="CDPH website">CDPH website</a> (https://www.cdph.ca.gov/Programs/CHCQ/LCP/Pages/DistrictOffices.aspx). Once you access the link above, you will see counties listed under each district office address. Determining which county the health facility is in will help you determine which district office to serve.
