



**A.** Clue: One in every 276 Californians is an alum of this UC campus. Famous alumni include two astronauts and chef Martin Yan.




**B.** Clue: The newest among this university system campuses was authorized in 1988 and is planning to open a School of Medicine in the future.




**C.** Clue: The first campus in this university system and one of the most famous CA colleges.



**D.** Clue: Eddie Murphy's "The Nutty Professor" was filmed at this campus, which was originally established as a branch of another CA school.




**E.** Clue: All of these grew out of Weekly Normal School (a training school for elementary teachers), established in 1857. Bonus: name five of them...

**H.** Clue: These two California schools share Rank 4 in the US News and World Report 2010 list of best colleges in the country.




**I.** Clue: "The Graduate" filmed a scene here.
