


## Focus Area 14: Immunization and Infectious Diseases

**Objective 14-2. Reduce chronic hepatitis B virus (HBV) infections in infants and young children (ages under 2 years). Target = 51 reported cases [State Data Sources: Perinatal Hepatitis B Prevention Programs; CDPH Immunization Branch]**

Available data indicate California has achieved this HP2010 objective each year from 2000 through 2007 (**Figure 14-2**). Cases of perinatal HBV infections among California children under age two declined overall from 40 cases in 2000 to 12 in 2007.
