## **VITAL AND HEALTH STATISTICS 2010 TRUST FUND REPORT**

The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) prepares the Vital and Health Statistics Trust Fund Report pursuant to Health and Safety (H&S) Code Section 103641(a). H&S Code Section 103625(j) requires each county that has established a local vital and health statistics trust fund to submit to the CDPH State Registrar (SR) information on the amount of revenues collected pursuant to H&S Code Section 103625(f) in the previous calendar year. It includes information on how those revenues were expended and for what purpose. Attachment A is a copy of the SR's request to counties and local health jurisdictions for their trust fund reports.

The statutory intent for the funds is to enhance services to the public, to improve analytical capabilities, and to analyze the health status of the general population. H&S Code Section 103625(h) provides for monies collected in the local and vital statistics trust funds to be available to local officials charged with the collection of vital record fees for the purpose of defraying their administrative costs for collecting and reporting with respect to those fees and for other costs including: modernization of vital record operations, improvement in the collection and analysis of health-related birth and death certificate information and other community related data collection and analysis. The fees must not be used to supplant funding in existence on January 1, 2002.

In Calendar Year 2010, 56 counties and three local jurisdictions had established a local vital and health statistics trust fund and reported a cumulative trust fund balance of \$30 million for Calendar Year 2010 (Table A). The cumulative trust fund balance reported for 2010 represented an increase of about \$2.6 million from what was reported for the prior calendar year (Table B). Of the counties and local jurisdictions that reported in 2010, most reflected an increase in the trust fund balance from the prior calendar year (Table C).

Vital record fees for birth, death, and marriage certificates collected pursuant to H&S Code Section 103625(f) plus any interest earned totaled a reported \$6.3 million in trust fund revenues for Calendar Year 2010 (Table D). This was about \$0.2 million less than reported for the prior calendar year (Tables E and F). Counties and local jurisdictions reported 2010 trust fund expenditures totaling \$3.8 million in equipment, consultants, administrative fees, and other operating costs (Table G). This represented a decrease of about \$0.8 million in expenditures from the prior calendar year (Tables H and I). Reported trust fund expenditures in 2010 were lower than reported revenues for that same year.
