




ADAP Update

ADAP Update

Insurance Benefits Management and Medical Benefits Management Contractor:

On September 4, 2015, ADAP released a request for proposal (RFP) for insurance benefits management (IBM) and medical benefits management (MBM) services. The purpose of this RFP was to select contractor(s) to administer premium and medical out-of-pocket cost payments for eligible clients. On January 5, 2016, both IBM and MBM service contracts were awarded to one qualified bidder, Pool Administrators, Inc. which will allow for coordinated insurance benefits. The contract was executed on March 2, 2016. ADAP is working with the contractor on the implementation phase with the goal of providing services starting July 1, 2016.

ADAP Update

Pharmacy Benefits Management Contractor:

On October 20, 2015, ADAP, in collaboration with the Department of General Services (DGS), released a RFP for Pharmacy Benefits Management (PBM) services. The purpose of this RFP is to select a contractor to administer the ADAP statewide pharmacy network and manage patient medication services for ADAP clients. ADAP's current contract expires on June 30, 2016; this current contract includes both pharmaceutical services and enrollment services. This contract was awarded to Magellan Rx Management, on March 11, 2016. The new PBM contractor currently maintains a large pharmacy network in California ensuring a seamless transition for clients accessing their life-saving medications. Magellan Rx Management will begin providing PBM services throughout the state effective July 1, 2016.

ADAP Update

Enrollment Benefits Management Contractor:

On October 20, 2015, an RFP was released for enrollment benefits management (EBM) services. The purpose of this RFP is to select a contractor to manage an enrollment system to track benefits and coverage for eligible ADAP clients. The EBM contract was awarded to A.J. Boggs & Company on March 4, 2016. Clients will be able to provide and update eligibility information and view benefits via a secure web portal. Clients and enrollment workers will also be able to send messages and upload eligibility verification documentation through this secure web portal.

ADAP Update

Enhancing Enrollment Processes – Data Matches

ADAP has been working towards conducting the following data matches for the purpose of easing the burden on clients and enrollment workers to provide verifying eligibility documentation:

- Medi-Cal Eligibility Data System (MEDS) – Medi-Cal data
- California Franchise Tax Board (FTB) – income data
- HIV/AIDS Reporting System (eHARS) – CD4 and VL data
- California Healthcare Enrollment, Eligibility and Retention System (CalHEERS) - Covered California data

ADAP Update

Enhancing Enrollment Worker Training – Online Training Modules

Through the California Statewide Training and Education Program (CSTEP), OA has contracted with Asian and Pacific Islander Wellness Center to provide online self-paced courses on ADAP policies and procedures. Participants will be able to log in and out as they please in order to complete the course at a comfortable pace for them. These modules will be available by July 1, 2016 and include the following:

- ADAP Medication Program Eligibility Requirements
- ADAP Insurance Assistance Programs and Requirements
- Security and Confidentiality of ADAP Data

ADAP Update

Funding Local Enrollment Sites

- In FY 2015-16, each LHJ allocation is based on the proportion of all ADAP clients (Medication Program) the LHJ enrolled during the prior year.
- In FY 2016-17, ADAP will pay the enrollment site directly on a quarterly basis based on actual ADAP (Medication Program and Insurance Assistance Programs) enrollment data for the previous quarter. In the instance where the enrollment site does not provide at least one ADAP enrollment during the current FY, the enrollment site will not be paid by ADAP for that FY.

ADAP Update

Re-Organization of the ADAP Branch

- Under the previous ADAP Branch organizational structure, ADAP's Medication Program and Insurance Assistance Programs were separated into two sections.
- Under the new ADAP organizational structure, the Branch is comprised of an ADAP Policy and Fiscal Section, and an ADAP Eligibility and Operations Section. The latter is comprised of four units that administer both the Medication Assistance and Insurance Assistance Programs. These units will also be performing the secondary review of all ADAP client files and applications once that mechanism is established in July 2016.
