







License Cultivators

Category	Outdoor	Indoor	Mixed-light
Specialty Cultivator	Type 1 Up to 5,000 sq ft, or up to 50 mature plants	Type 1a Up to 5,000 sq ft	Type 1b Up to 5,000 sq ft
Small Cultivator	Type 2 5,001-10,000 sq ft	Type 2a 5,001-10,000 sq ft	Type 2b 5,001-10,000 sq ft
Cultivator	Type 3 10,001 sq ft- 1 acre	Type 3a 10,001- 22,000 sq ft	Type 3b 10,001- 22,000 sq ft

Collaboration


- **Licensing Authorities**

Track and Trace

- **Stand up a system to be used by all three licensing authorities**
- **Track cannabis from cultivation to sale using a unique ID**
- **Prevent diversion and inversion**
- **Protect human health through tracking if necessary**
