## Program Information

In 1984, the Maternal Child Health Branch of the Department of Health Services established the California Diabetes and Pregnancy Program (CDAPP) as a part of the Regional Perinatal Programs of California (RPPC).

“Sweet Success,” the clinical component of CDAPP, is intended to improve pregnancy outcome for its target group: women with pre-existing diabetes and women who develop gestational diabetes. The goal is to reduce maternal and infant mortality and morbidity for this high-risk group to approximate the outcomes of the low-risk perinatal population.

The Sweet Success program is based on the use of trained multidisciplinary teams composed of physicians, nurses, dietitians, social workers, and other health care professionals. Studies have shown that after adjusting for inflation and differences in charges across hospitals, \$5.19 are saved for every \$1 spent on the Sweet Success program. This saving was based on the use of the multidisciplinary team to provide comprehensive services to the target population.

The program emphasizes early recruitment of pre-pregnant and pregnant women with diabetes, into pregnancy programs managed by multidisciplinary teams. These professionals integrate specialized assessment and intervention strategies to meet the challenge of providing optimal care for the target group.

The program provides the following services to to the pre-pregnant and pregnant woman with diabetes:

- ❖ outpatient-based comprehensive education,
- ❖ nutrition,
- ❖ psychosocial, and
- ❖ medical services

The intent is to achieve active participation by the woman, in managing the meal plan, insulin, stress, exercise regimens and psychosocial concerns necessary for optimal glycemic control and perinatal outcomes.

Within CDAPP regions, clinical affiliate units are established to provide the services necessary to achieve the desired program outcomes. The affiliates provide a network of trained providers and agencies that assume the responsibility for coordinating and providing appropriate care to the target group within each perinatal region.







**Guidelines for Diagnosis of Hyperglycemia in Pregnancy – 2011**

**First Prenatal Visit (< 13 wks)\***

Many cases of diabetes or abnormal glucose tolerance are not detected until pregnancy. Early detection reduces complications.

**Test:** Women who have ANY risk factor:

- Non-Caucasian
- BMI ≥ 25 (at risk BMI may be lower in some ethnic groups<sup>1</sup>)
- History of GDM or pre-diabetes, unexplained stillbirth, malformed infant
- Previous baby 4000 gm or more (8 lbs 13 oz)
- 1st degree relative with DM
- Glucosuria
- Medications that raise glucose (e.g. steroids, beta-agonists, atypical antipsychotics)
- Polycystic ovarian syndrome (PCOS), CVD, HTN, hyperlipidemia

**ALTERNATE: Test all women for undiagnosed hyperglycemia at the first visit**

**Universal Testing at 24-28 wks**

- 2011 ADA<sup>2</sup> standard is 75 gm 2h OGTT for all women not previously diagnosed with diabetes @ 24-28 wks GA
- Fast 8 - 10 hours, remains seated during test
- Consider adding to third trimester labs
