Question 1: Please clarify the Application due date, there is more than one due date on the RFA?

Response: *The application Due Date is **April 19, 2019 at 4 PM**. This clarification was addressed on [addendum #1](#).*

Question 2: Can you please provide more detail to the strategies to be implemented for Goal 4?

Response: *The strategies noted on the RFA for Goal 4 are still under development. More background on the maternal risk-appropriate care efforts underway have been provided through addendum #2 accompanied by **Appendix #1- Summary of 2018 – 2019 Maternal Risk-Appropriate Care Efforts**. Question 3: Do we have to include the addendums in the proposal? If so, what section should they be included in?

Response: *The addendum themselves do not need to be included on the RFA Application, but the content and clarifications provided on the addendum, should be considered and applied when responding to the RFA. The corrections or clarification provided through the addendums takes precedence over the content on the RFA.*

Question 4: The budget spreadsheet – attachment 4 seems to only allow for up to 10 personnel to be listed – is that a limit? If not, please advice as to how to expand that section?

Response: *There is no limit to how many staff an applicant can add to the budget. If you need to add more than ten staff to the budget, please submit your request to RPPC.RFA@cdph.ca.gov and we will send it out to you.*

Question 5: On page 16 item 4 it specifies a USB format for the application but in item d it says CD – do you need both? Or just USB?

Response: *Please submit electronic copies of the application via USB only, not a CD.*
