AB 272	<p>Rabies: vaccinations (Gomez)</p> <p>Existing law imposes various requirements upon dog owners in rabies areas designated by the State Public Health Officer.</p> <p>Among the requirements imposed under existing law is that a dog 4 months of age or older be vaccinated against rabies.</p> <p>This bill would require that a dog 3 months of age or older be vaccinated against rabies. AB 332	<p>Occupational safety and health: adult films (Hall)</p> <p>This bill would require an employer engaged in the production of an adult film to adopt prescribed practices and procedures to protect employees from exposure to, and infection by, sexually transmitted diseases, including engineering and work practice controls, an exposure control plan, hepatitis B vaccinations, medical monitoring, and information and training on health and safety. The bill would require Occupational Safety and Health Standards Board to adopt emergency regulations to implement these provisions by July 1, 2014.</p>	<p>LAST HIST. ACT. SB 249	<p>Public health: health records: confidentiality (Leno)  Under the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA), each state is required to, by January 1, 2014, establish an American Health Benefit Exchange that makes available qualified health plans to qualified individuals and small employers.  The bill would authorize the State Department of Public Health, subject to specified provisions, to share health records involving the diagnosis, care, and treatment of HIV or AIDS related to a beneficiary enrolled in federal Ryan White Act-funded programs who may be eligible for services under the PPACA with participating entities, as defined, in health care coverage expansions under the PPACA.
