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Dear Cosmetic Companies:

There have been several updates to the California Safe Cosmetics Reporting System.

Updates to the Chemical List - The List of Chemicals Known or Suspected to Cause Cancer or Reproductive Toxicity has been updated based on information provided by California Proposition 65 and other authoritative bodies. There are a number of new chemicals on this list, including **benzophenone** and **diethanolamine**. The full list can be accessed at: <http://www.cdph.ca.gov/programs/cosmetics/Documents/chemlist.pdf>. Additions to the list are noted in blue font.

Updates to Product Categorization - The product categorization page has been updated. The intended application area now includes a checkbox for “Nails”.

Based on data reported to the system, the product categories have been edited to cover a wider range of products. New categories include:

- Baby Products: Baby Wash/Soap
- Bath Products: Body Washes and Soaps
- Makeup Products: Mascara/Eyelash Products
- Nail Products: UV Gel Nail Polish

Please note, while the option to check “Other” is still available, there is no longer space to add text describing your product.

Automatic E-mailing of Receipts - When you have completed product submittal, including the electronic signature page, the reporting system will now automatically create a receipt for the completed report and send the receipt to the e-mail address provided. You will still be able to download receipts from the webpage, both at the time of reporting and during subsequent logins.

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Redirect after Timeout - Finally, the timeout feature of the system which automatically ends a login session after fifteen minutes of inactivity has been changed. If your session times out, you will be directed back to the login page where you can re-enter your User ID and password.

We thank you for the time and effort it takes to comply with the California Safe Cosmetics Act and hope that these changes to the website will facilitate the process.

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
