You could be eligible for CalFresh (formerly known as food stamps) if you answer YES to these questions:

- 1. Are you a resident of San Joaquin County? YES
- 2. Is someone in your household a U.S. Citizen or Legal Permanent Resident of the U.S., refugee or asylee? YES
- 3. Is your gross monthly income below the limits on the chart listed below? YES
- 4. Are you a senior or disabled adult (you may still qualify if your income is above the amount listed on the chart below)? YES
